

The State Soil Conservation Board met in executive session on June 10th, 1939.

After considerable discussion, on the motion of H. K. Fawcett, seconded by J. E. Martin, a committee of two, Walter W. Cardwell and V. C. Marshall, were appointed to make investigations as to the logical location, as to rents and other factors, for the State office of the Texas State Soil Conservation Board; to advise with the Attorney General's Department relative to the duties and responsibilities of the State Soil Conservation Board, and request that Department to make a digest of the Texas Soil Conservation Law in simple language as may be understood by the rank and file of the people; and to report their committee findings to the Board at its next regular meeting, which is determined as June 26th, 1939.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned.
