
The minutes of the last meeting held January 14, 1954, were read and approved.

A letter from Mr Paul H Walser, Deputy State Conservationist, regarding a proposed petition for the forming of a new Soil Conservation District Randall County and a part of Potter County, was read and discussed not action taken as the Petition had not been received.

The report of the committees who inspected the San Antonio and Mineral Wells requests for the 1955 Annual Meeting of the State Board and the State Association of District Supervisors was received. After a lengthy discussion of both sites a motion was made by Mr A F Leesh, seconded by E W Wehman that San Antonio be selected; motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr E W Wehman, seconded by C M Caraway, Sr, that three of the Board Personnel attend the National Association of District Supervisors meeting to be held in New Orleans, La, February 23, 24 and 25, 1954, if convenient. The Attorney General be requested to grant permission for them to attend this meeting.
