

MINUTES
TEXAS STATE SOIL CONSERVATION BOARD
MARCH 4, 1946

The Texas State Soil Conservation Board met in it's offices at Temple, Texas, March 4, 1946 at 9:00 a.m.

The meeting was called to order by Walter W. Cardwell, Chairman. Members present were J. P. Martin, C. M. Caraway, Horace K. Fawcett and S. J. Payne, also present were V. C. Marshall, Executive Director, Howard H. Goss, Chief of Engineering and Planning and Paul H. Walser, State Conservationist, Soil Conservation Service. The minutes of the meeting of January 28, 1946 were read and approved. At this time Mr. Cardwell submitted his resignation as chairman of the Board and requested that another member be elected as he thought the rotation of chairmanship of the Board would be beneficial to the best interests of the Board. Mr. C. M. Caraway was nominated to succeed Mr. Cardwell and was unanimously elected. Mr. Caraway then took over the duties as chairman of the Board and proceeded with the business at hand.

The determination of need for the creation of soil conservation districts in the following areas was considered and approved: Gillespie County No. 220, Nueces-Frio-Sabinal No. 221, Brooks County No. 328, Refugio County No. 329 and Bexar County No. 330. The determination of need for the inclusion of additional territory of districts already organized was also considered and approved, they are: Highland No. 210, Miller-Brazos No. 526 and San Diego-Agua Dulce No. 311. The supervisors of the Highland S.C.D. No. 210 and Brown-Mills No. 523 submitted changes in boundaries on subdivisions in their soil conservation districts with maps showing the new boundaries and locations. These changes were approved by the Board. Consideration of the election authorized on Kleberg County petition was discussed and a motion was made ~~and~~ action by the Board on granting this election be ~~re~~tabled.

After the noon luncheon the Board took up consideration of recommendations for the biennial appropriation for the years 1947 and 1948 and tentative recommendations to be submitted to the Board of Control.

Their being no further business for the attention of the Board at this time adjournment was taken at 3:00 p.m.
