



## TEXAS STATE SOIL CONSERVATION BOARD

The State Soil conservation Board met in Fort Worth, Texas, at the Texas Hotel, March 11, 1953, at 8 o'clock p.m., with the following Members present, Horace K Fawcett, Chairman, C M Caraway, Sr, S J Payne and E W Wehman. Others present were V C Marshall, Executive Director, Roy Gough, Assistant State Soil Conservationist of the Soil Conservation Service and William R Heizer.

The minutes of the last meeting of the Board held in College Station, Texas, February 19, 20, 1953, were read and approved.

The Board discussed with Mr William R Heizer his employment as a Field Engineer to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of Mr Curtis Bell. Mr Heizer advised the Board he would accept the position on a date to be designated later.

There was a general discussion with Mr Roy Gough concerning problems of the Soil Conservation Service with Soil Conservation Districts and District Supervisors. He advised that they were having fine cooperation.

The Board adjourned at 10 o'clock p.m. to meet the following morning with Mr Louis P Merrill, Regional Conservator of the Soil Conservation Service at the District Office.

On the morning of March 12, 1953, the Board spent three hours with Mr Merrill in a discussion of their mutual problems and a tour of the facilities of the Regional Office.

The Board adjourned at Noon.
