



TEXAS STATE SOIL CONSERVATION BOARD

Austin, Texas, March 18, 1947.

The State Soil Conservation Board met in Austin, Texas, March 18, 1947, 8:30 p.m. with the following members present, C.M.Caraway, Chairman, J.P.Martin, Walter W. Cardwell, Horace K. Fawcett, and S.J.Payne. A.L.Liles, Executive Asst., was also present.

The place of holding the convention for the election of a State Board Member from State District No.4, was discussed and Mr.Martin made a motion, seconded by Mr.Payne, that the convention be held in Crockett May, 6, 1947, motion carried.

A letter from Mr.G.G.Goss, Chairman of the Bronw-Mills Soil Conservation District No.523, inviting the State Board to designate Brownwood as the place to hold the State Meeting of the Association of Texas Soil Conservation District Supervisors for the year 1947, was read and Mr.Fawcett made a motion, seconded by Mr.Cardwell, that said invitation be accepted and that a date near the 10th of December be designated, motion unanimously adopted.

After a general discussion of duties and responsibilities of the Board Mr.Fawcett made a motion, seconded by Mr.Cardwell, that the next meeting of the State Board be held with the Director of the Extension Service in College Station, and that the Executive Director be requested to arrange said meeting on or near April 15, to 20th, 1947, motion carried Unanimously.

A motion was made by Mr.Payne, seconded by Mr.Cardwell, that an effort be made to secure publication of articles on the Soil Conservation work in Texas in some National Magazines, motion carried unanimously.

The then discussed the status of the Work Unit Leaders of the S.C.S, and unpon motion by Mr.Cardwell and seconded by Mr.Fawcett, the Chairman, C.M.Caraway, was requested to ascertain from Mr.L.P.Merrill, Regional Consevator, why Work Unit Leaders were not permitted to meet with Boards of Supervisors, motion carried unanimously.

No further business appearing for attention the meeting was adjourned at 10:30 p.m.
