MINUTES OF MEETING OF STATE SOIL CONSERVATION BOARD, TEMPLE, TEXAS MARCH 28, 1950

The State Soil Conservation Board met in Temple on March 28, 1950, with the following members present: C. M. Caraway, Sr., Chairman; J. P. Martin; S. J. Payne; and E. W. Wehman. Others present were V. C. Marshall, Howard H. Goss, Louis B. Dawkins and Paul H. Walser.

Minutes of the meeting of February 19 and 20 were read and approved.

A Determination of Need for the organization of a Soil Conservation District in Jackson County was approved; also the need for the annexation of additional territory to the Upper Leon Soil Conservation District No. 525.

The following Determinations and Practicability and Feasibility were approved: Roberts County No. 145, as of February 19, 1950; Hutchinson No. 146, as of February 24, 1950; Crockett No. 235, as of March 28, 1950; and Zapata No. 335, as of March 1, 1950.

Upon motion duly passed it was directed that a letter be sent to Mr. Paul H. Walser, State Conservationist, Soil Conservation Service, in appreciation of his assistance in the meeting with the Highway Commission in Austin to promote a better understanding of their mutual problems.

A motion was duly passed that the Governor be requested to grant a deficiency appropriation to Appropriation M-1726, mileage for delegates to a district meeting to be held in State District No. 3 for the purpose of electing a State Board Member, the first Tuesday in May.

It was agreed that funds withheld for that part of Maverick County not included in the Maverick County District be allocated to the Maverick County Soil Conservation District in the amount of \$5,669.00.

No further business appearing for attention the Board adjourned at 12 m.
