

The State Soil Conservation Board met in executive session at Temple, Texas on Monday, May 29, 1939.

Mr. H. K. Fawcett moved that Mr. V. C. Marshall be elected Chairman of the State Soil Conservation Board. Mr. Walter Cardwell seconded the motion. Mr. W. C. Kennedy put the motion which carried by a majority.

Mr. W. C. Kennedy moved that the members of the Board make an investigation trip to the states of Arkansas and Oklahoma in invitation to the Conservation Service for the purpose of gaining knowledge and information with reference to the operation of the districts in those states. The motion was seconded, and carried by a majority.

The Board adjourned until Monday, June 5, when it will reconvene in Temple, Texas at 8 o'clock.
