The State Soil Conservation Board met in the Blackstone Hotel, Tyler, Texas, on May 29, 1952, at 9 o'clock a.m., with the following present: J P Martin, Chairman, C M Caraway, Sr, E W Wehman members of the Board. Also present were V C Marshall, Executive Director and A L Liles, Secretary.


The Minutes of the Meeting of the Board, May 1, 1952, were read and approved.

Mr Marshall reported on meetings he had attended with the Implement Dealers to discuss with them their opportunity to assist in the Soil and Water Conservation Program. He advised that he believed much good would accrue from these contacts as all of the Implement Dealers were interested and cooperative in the program.

The election of a State Board Member for State District No. 4 was held in Crockett, Texas, on May 6, 1952, as provided by Law and Mr J P Martin was again elected to serve another five year term. A statement from the Chairman of the Convention, Dan C Sparks, signed by the Secretary, Jeff O Chumley, was filed with the Board advising of the election of Mr J P Martin.

The Board having approved the policy of selecting a new Chairman at the first meeting of the Board after the election of a State Board Member the first tuesday in May of each year Mr Horace K. Fawcett was selected Chairman for the current year.

The meeting as adjourned at 10 o'clock a.m. so that all could attend a Conservation Meeting at Legion Hall for the distribution of the Fort Worth Press awards to winners in the East Texas area.
