Mr. Lukas and Mr. Lee of Brownwood appeared before the Board, being interested in the creation of a soil conservation district in Brown and Mills Counties. After some discussion with Members of the Board, it was agreed that such a combination as the proposed district apparently was feasible, and the same was so recommended by the Board.

On motion by Judge Kennedy, seconded by Mr. Fawcett, it was ordered that nominating petitions for elections which are to be held on August 31st in thirty districts should reach the office not later than June 29th. It was further ordered on motion by Mr. Caraway, seconded by Mr. Martin, that the returns of said election should be in the mails within 72 hours after the closing of the polls.

On motion by Mr. Caraway, seconded by Mr. Kennedy, District No. 107,

Crosby County; No. 108, Lubbock County; 109, Hale County; 110 Swisher County; 111, Blackwater Valley; [REDACTED]; 426, Smith County; 427, Cherokee County; 522, Bosque; 524, Upper Elm-Red; and 525, Upper Leon, were approved subject to the preparation and drafting of proper field notes.

On motion by Mr. Caraway, seconded by Mr. Kennedy, it was ordered that elections for the creation of new districts be held on October 19th.

After discussing an invitation extended to the Board to attend the Short Course at A. & M. College, the Chair appointed Mr. Martin, Mr. Kennedy, and Mr. Caraway to attend the Short Course if possible in the capacity as representatives of the State Board.

After considerable discussion, it was ordered that where possible, hearings be held prior to August 1st, in the following districts:

The preparation of an annual report was discussed briefly, after which, it was determined that material be assembled as a Progress Report to be published in bulletin form, and that the Extension Service, and the Soil Conservation Service, be requested to assist in the preparation of the Progress Report.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned, subject to call.
