MINUTES OF STATE SOIL CONSERVATION BOARD MEETING

AUGUST 16, 1944.

THE STATE SOIL CONSERVATION BOARD MET IN CHILDRESS, TEXAS, ON AUGUST 16, 1944, AT 1 P.M., WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS PRESENT: C.M.CARAWAY, J.P.MARTIN AND W.M.DECK. OTHERS PRESENT WERE V.C.MARSHALL, ADMINISTRATOR, AND A.L.LILES, ASSISTANT AND CLERK. THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING AT DUBLON, TEXAS, JULY 12, 1944, WERE READ AND APPROVED.

UPON MOTION BY J.P.MARTIN, SECONDED BY W.M.DECK, C.M.CARAWAY WAS DESIGNATED AS ACTING CHAIRMAN FOR THIS MEETING.

A PUBLIC HEARING HAVING BEEN HELD AT BENAVIDES, DUVAL COUNTY, TEXAS, ON JULY 26, 1944, ON A PROPOSED SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT TO INCLUDE ALL OF DUVAL COUNTY, TEXAS, NOT NOW INCLUDED IN A SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT. THE BOARD, UPON MOTION BY J.P.MARTIN, SECONDED BY W.M.DECK, CONSIDERED AND DETERMINED THAT THERE IS A NEED FOR A SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT IN THIS AREA, TO BE KNOWN AS AGUA POQUITA No. 321.

THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED AT 1:30 P.M., TO ATTEND THE DISTRICT MEETING OF THE DISTRICT SUPERVISORS THEN BEING HELD IN CHILDRESS, IN THE DISTRICT COURT ROOM.
