TEXAS STATE SOIL CONSERVATION BOARD TEMPLE. TEXAS

The Texas State Soil Conservation Board met in it's offices in Temple, Texas April 26, 1946 at 8;30 a.m. The meeting was called to order by C.M. Caraway, Chairman. Members present were J. P. Martin, Horace K. Fawcett and S. J. Payne, also present were V. C. Marshall, Executive Director, Howard H. Goss, Chief of Engineering and Planning and Paul H. Walser, State Conservationist, Soil Conservation Service. Mr. Walter W. Cardwell joined the Board in Austin on the 27th.

The minutes of the meeting of March 4, 1946 were read and approved.

The Determination of Need for the creation of soil conservation districts in the following areas were considered and approved: Gaines County No. 128, Hockley County No. 129, Lamb County No. 130 and Dallam County No. 131, Also the annexation to the Karnes County SoilConservation District of the territory located in Bee County.

Approval was given as to the Practicability and Feasibility of the anmexation of additional territory to the Miller-Brazos Soil Conservation District No. 526, also to the San Diego-Agua Dulce No. 311.

The supervisors of the Upper Elm Red Soil Conservation District submitted changes in the boundaries of subdivisions Nos 3 and 4 which were approved.

A change in the boundary in subdivisions 4 and 5 of the Willacy-Hidalgo Soil Conservation District No. 312 was submitted and approved.

The ellimination of that part of Brooks County owned by the King Ranch from the Brooks County Soil Conservation District was approved.

The Board then adjourned to attend a meeting of the Friends of The Land at the Municipal Auditorium beginning at 1:00 p.m. and lasting until 3:00 p.m. The Board then adjourned to meet in Austin with the State Board of Control at 10:30 a.m. Saturday morning April 27, 1946.

APRIL 27, 1946, 10:30 a.m.

The State Board met with the State Board of Control for a discussion of the budget for the next biennium. The appropriations requested were discussed in detail and at the suggestion of Mr. C. M. Caraway, Chairman, it was decided to ask for a 15% raise in the salaries of the secretary and stenographer of the Board. The meeting was then adjourned at 11;30 a.m.
