MINUTES OF STATE SOIL CONSERVATION BOARD MEETING, DECEMBER 6, 1944.

THE STATE SOIL CONSERVATION BOARD MET IN COLLEGE STATION, TEXAS, DECEMBER 6, 1944, AT 1 P.M. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY WALTER W. CARDWELL, CHAIRMAN. THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS OF THE BOARD WERE PRESENT, J.P.MARTIN AND HORACE K. FAWCETT, ALSO MR.V.C.MARSHALL, ADMINISTRATOR.

THIS MEETING WAS CALLED FOR THE TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS AND TO ATTEND THE STATE MEETING OF THE ASSOCIATION OF TEXAS SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT SUPERVISORS.

THEN CAME ON THE DETERMINATION AS TO THE NEED FOR THE CREATION OF A SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT IN EACH OF THE FOLLOWING AREAS;

POLK COUNTY, No.436.
LOWER NECHES, HARDIN COUNTY, No.437.
UPPER NECHES, ANGELINA COUNTY, No.438,

THE BOARD HAVING CONDUCTED A FULL HEARING IN EACH OF THESE AREAS IT WAS, THEREFORE, CONSIDERED AND DETERMINED THAT THERE IS NEED, IN THE INTEREST OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE, FOR A SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT TO FUNCTION IN THE TERRITORY CONSIDERED.

THE ATTORNEY GENERAL HAVING RENDERED A DECISION THAT IT WAS PERMISSIBLE TO ORGANIZE A SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT IN TERRITORY COVERED BY A WIND EROSION DISTRICT, THE BOARD, AFTER GENERAL DISCUSSION, APPROVED AND AGREED TO INVITE WIND EROSION DISTRICTS TO PARTICIPATE WITH S.C.D.
