The State Soil Conservation Board met in Fort Worth, Texas, Texas Hotel, May 2, 1953, at 5:30, o'clock p.m., with the following members present; Horace K Fawcett, Chairman, C M Caraway, Sr, E W Wehman and J P Martin. Others present, A C Spencer, William R Heizer, Field Planning Engineers, Paul Walser, State Conservationist of the Soil Conservation Service and his Assistant Roy Gough, Henry Mills, President of the State Association of State District Supervisors and John B Cole of Soil and Water Magazine; also G G Gibson, Chief of the Staff of the Extension Service A & M College.

The Minutes of the last meeting of the Board held in Fort Worth, Texas, March 11, 1953, were read and approved.

Mr G G Gibson of the Extension Service discussed with the Board the Memorandum of Agreement between his Department and the Board. It was the consensus of opinion of the Board Members that the Extension Service was doing a very fine job on cooperation with the Soil Conservation Districts.

The Board then discussed the annual meeting of the State Association of District Supervisors which is to be held in Fort Worth, Texas, in January, 1954. Mr Fawcett advised that he had inspected the Will Rogers Cliseum as a place for holding the meeting stating that he would recommend same as being an ideal place for this meeting as all facilities for the various activities of the meeting could be accommodated. A motion was made and passed that the Executive Director be instructed to contact Congressman Poage and Clifford Hope and Secretary Benson of the Department of Agriculture regarding appearance at this meeting.

The Board adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
