The State Soil Conservation Board met in its Office July 1, 1952, at 9 o'clock a.m., with the following members and visitors present: C M Caraway, Sr, J P Martin, S J Payne and E W Wehman. Also V C Marshall, Executive Director, A C Spencer, Field Representative and Paul Walser, State Soil Conservationist.

The Minutes of the last meeting held May 29, at the Blackstone Hotel, Tyler, Texas, were read and approved.

A trip to be made by the Board to far west Texas area for inspection of results of Conservation practices was set for the week beginning August 31, 1952., the Board to assemble at Del Rio, Texas, on that date and to proceed north through Sanderson, Marathon, Big Bend Park, Alpine, Marfa and El Paso.

At 10 o'clock the Board met with Mr Vernon A McGee, Executive Director of the Legislative Budget Board, also Jess Irwin, and Mr R B Baldwin of the Budget Board Division of the Governor's Office.

These gentlemen came to discuss with the Board its accomplishments in the field of Soil Conservation and its future work. This discussion was for the purpose of justifying the Board's request for funds to be appropriated for its operation during the next biennium beginning September 1, 1953 and ending August 31, 1955. All questions asked by this committee were fully answered by the Board, Mr V C Marshall, Executive Director and Mr Paul Walser, State Conservationist for the Soil Conservation Service.

Mr S J Payne, was designated as Chairman for this meeting as the present Chairman, Horace K Fawcett was not present.

The Board adjourned at 12 o'clock noon.
