MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE STATE SOIL CONSERVATION BOARD, AUGUST 14, 1950

The State Soil Conservation Board met in its office at Temple, Texas, on August 14, 1950 at 8:00 A.M. Board members present were C. M. Caraway, Sr., chairman; J. P. Martin, H. K. Fawcett, S. J. Payne and E. W. Wehman.

The minutes of the meeting of May 17, 1950 were read and approved.

A determination of need for the inclusion of additional territory, and the defining of boundaries of same, of the annexations to the following districts were approved: Nos. 8, 9, and 10 to the Upper Leon Soil Conservation District No. 525 were approved as of July 5, 1950, Polk County #436 as of July 17, 1950. The determination of need for the organization of a district in Hansford County No. 148 was approved as of June 9, 1950.

A determination that the operation of a soil conservation district in Hansford County is administratively practicable and feasible was approved as of July 26, 1950. Also the determination that the inclusion of additional territory in the Upper Leon Soil Conservation District No. 525, Nos. 8, 9, 10 and 11, were approved as of July 5, 1950. Also the inclusion of additional territory to Polk County No. 436 was approved as of August 14, 1950. Also the annexation to Collin County No. 535 was approved as of June 7, 1950.

A determination that the operation of a district in Kinney County, Las Moras No. 236, was not practicable and feasible as the vote was less than 2/3 majority.

Upon motion made by H. K. Fawcett, seconded by S. J. Payne, the final allotment of the balance of the grant of \$2,500,000 by the State to the several soil conservation districts, amounting to \$171,406.00, was approved.

With no further business appearing for attention, the Board adjourned at 10:00 A.M.
