Others present; V C Marshall, Executive Director and Paul Walser, State Conservationist.


The minutes of the last Board meeting were read and approved.

The election for the organization of a Soil Conservation District in part of Wharton have failed to secure a majority vote it was determined by the Board that it would not be practicable or feasible to operate a District in that area.

Mr Marshall reported that Mr W R Heizer had tendered his resignation as a Field Planning Engineer for the Board and that he would recommend the employment of Mr O F Armstrong, of Nacogdoches, Texas, to fill the vacancy.

Mr F A Leesch made a motion that the resignation of Mr W R Heizer be accepted and that Mr O F Armstrong be employed to fill the vacancy, with his headquarters to be made at Abilene within a reasonable time. Mr Armstrong's appointment to be approved as of October 16, 1953.

No further business appearing for attention the Board adjourned at 9:30 o'clock p.m.
