The State Soil Conservation Board met at the Stockton Hotel, Fort Stockton, Texas on November 27, 1950 at 8:30 A.M. with the following Board members present: C. M. Caraway, Sr., Chairman, Horace K. Fawcett, J. P. Martin, S. J. Payne, and E. W. Wehman. Others present were V. C. Marshall, Executive Director, Howard H. Goss, John B. Cole, Paul Walser, and E. E. Haverlah.

The minutes of the last meeting held October 9 were read and approved as read.

Mr. Marshall reviewed for the Board procedures being used by the District Boards in the use of and charge for use of District owned equipment. Mr. Marshall also reported that the office had worked out procedure with the State Board of Control for the purchase of tires, tubes, gasoline and oil on State contract. Mr. Marshall also stated that the Attorney General is to rule on whether or not District owned equipment was entitled to use free license plates.

No further business appearing for attention the Board adjourned at 9:45 o'clock a.m. to meet with the supervisors of the general area from 10:00 to 12:00 a.m., and to attend a range tour from 1:00 to 6:00 P.M. and to meet with the business people of Stockton from 7:00 to 10:00 P.M.
