



## TEXAS STATE SOIL CONSERVATION BOARD

The State Soil Conservation Board met in Fort Worth, Texas, May 10, 1947, with the following present; Chairman, J.P.Martin, C.M.Caraway, Walter W. Cardwell, S.J.Payne; Executive Director, V.C.Marshall, Chief, Engineering and Planning, Howard H. Goss, and Executive Assistant, A.L.Liles.

The Minutes of the meeting held in Bryan, Texas, March 28, 1947, read and approved.

A referendum having been held in Lipscomb County, April 5, 1947, the vote being 149 to 0, it was therefore considered and determined that the operation of a Soil Conservation District within the boundaries of Lipscomb County, as defined by the State Board is administratively practicable and feasible.

A motion was made by Mr.C.M.Caraway, seconded by Walter W. Cardwell, that Public Hearings having been held in the following areas and same being satisfactory to the Board, that a Determination of need for the organization of Soil Conservation Districts be approved and elections ordered in each;



The election for a State Board Member for State District Four, was held in Crockett, Texas, May 6, 1947. The Chairman of the Convention, Mr.John W. Scott, reported that Mr.J.P.Martin, of Martinsville, Texas, had been elected a Member of the State Board for a period of five years.

On motion made by Mr.C.M.Caraway, seconded by W.W.Cardwell, the State Meeting of the Assosiation of District Supervisors was set for December 9, 10, 1947, meeting to be held in Brownwood, Texas, motion carried.

A motion was made by Mr.W.W.Cardwell, seconded by Mr.C.M.Caraway, that Mr.Marshall and Mr.Goss make investigation as to the conditions existing at this time in Wharton County and if satisfactory to proceed with the election for a Soil Conservation District, carried.

No further business appearing for attention meeting was adjourned at 5 p.m.
