The minutes of the last meeting of the Board of March 29, 1954, were read and approved.


Time having arrived for the selection of a new Chairman for the Board a Motion was made by J P Martin, seconded by A F Leesch, Mr E W Wehman was selected to serve for the current year. Mr Wehman then assumed his duties as Chairman.

The Budget for the semi-annual period beginning September 1, 1955 and ending August 31, 1958, was submitted by the Executive Director, V C Marshall. The budget was studied and the Chairman, E W Wehman and Secretary, A L Liles, were instructed to meet with the Legislative Budget Committee and the budget committee of the Governor's Office for further study and approval.

The determination of the practability of the operation of a Soil Conservation District in Hartley County, to be known as Hartley Soil Conservation District No.152, was presented and upon motion by Mr S J Payne, seconded by C M Caraway, Sr, said determination was approved.

The appointment of Mr Dudley Smith as a supervisor for sub-division No.2 and Mr R E Whitaker as a supervisor for sub-division No.4 were approved upon motion made by F A Leesch, seconded by S J Payne, for the Hartley Soil Conservation District No.152.

The Board adjourned at 10 o'clock p.m.
