The State Soil Conservation Board met in Temple, July 25, 1951, with the following members present; J P Martin, Chairman, C M Caraway, Sr, Horace K Fawcett, S J Payne and E W Wehman. Others present were V C Marshall, Executive Director, Howard H Goss, Field Representative.

The minutes of the last meeting held June 14, 1951, were read and approved.

A motion was made and passed that a Determination of Need for the operation of a District in Wharton County be approved, as of July 9, 1951.

A motion was duly made and passed that the inclusion of additional territory to the Upper Leon District No. 525 is administratively practicable and feasible, as of July 16, 1951.

A lease for the office space now occupied was presented to the Board for the period beginning September 1, 1951 and ending August 31, 1953, and same was approved.

A suggested Memorandum of Agreement which had been presented to the Board at its meeting of May 5, 1951, by the Soil Conservation Service was again brought up for consideration and same was approved with some changes and additions. The Executive Director was instructed to present same to the Soil Conservation Service for their consideration.

It was suggested and agreed to that the next meeting of the Board would be held at College Station in September.

The Board adjourned at 9 a.m.
