The State Soil Conservation Board met at the Holland Hotel, Alpine, Texas, at 8 p.m., September 20, 1954.

Present: E. W. Wehmans, Chairman, S. J. Payne, Arthur Leesch, J. P. Martin; others present: A. C. Spencer, and V. C. Marshall.

The meeting was opened for any business by the chairman, Mr. Wehmans:

On motion by Mr. Payne, seconded by Mr. Leesch, the order of election on the creation of a district was approved for Randall and part of Potter County.

On motion by Mr. Leesch, and seconded by Mr. Martin, the Board approved the order for election in the proposed Nueces-Frio Soil Conservation District, boundaries to be on the basis of a map in preparation as approved at the public hearing on the creation of the district.

A letter from the board of supervisors of the Rio Grande-Pecos River District requesting certain subdivision changes was discussed by members of the board, and the matter was passed over to a future meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned to meet at Temple, Texas, on September 28th, at 9 a.m.
