The State Soil Conservation Board met in its offices at Temple, Texas, October 9, 1950, at 8 a.m. with the following Board Members present; C.M.Caraway, Sr., Chairman, Horace K. Fawcett, J.P.Martin, S.J.Payne and E.W.Wehman. Others present were V.C.Marshall, Executive Director, Howard H. Goss, and John B. Cole.

The minutes of the last meeting of the Board, held August 24, 1950, were read and approved.

Then came up for consideration the allocation of the \$2,500,000, appropriation made by the 51st Legislature for the year ending August 31, 1951. A Motion was made by Mr.E.W.Wehman, seconded by S.J.Payne that said funds be allocated on same basis as those for first year of the Biennium, which was 50% on number of farms and 50% on number of acers, Motion carried unanimous.

No further business appearing for attention the Board adjourned at 10 o'clock a.m.
