

MINUTES OF MEETING OF STATE SOIL CONSERVATION BOARD HELD ON DECEMBER 14,

1943

CISCO, TEXAS, DECEMBER 14, 1943.

THE STATE SOIL CONSERVATION BOARD MET IN CISCO, TEXAS, ON DECEMBER 14, 1943, AT 1 P.M., WITH MEMBERS WALTER W. CARDWELL, W.M. DECK, C.M. CARAWAY AND J.P. MARTIN PRESENT. OTHERS IN ATTENDANCE WERE V.C. MARSHALL, ADMINISTRATOR, AND A.L. LILES, ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT.

THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF NOVEMBER 23, 1943, WERE READ, AND ADOPTED AS READ, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE ACTION TAKEN ON THE CHANGE IN THE NAME OF THE KARNES COUNTY SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT. THIS CHANGE WAS APPROVED BY ACTION OF THE BOARD AT ITS MEETING OF NOVEMBER 23, 1943, AND UPON MOTION BY J.P. MARTIN, SECONDED BY W.M. DECK, THIS ACTION WAS RESCINDED. THIS CHANGE WAS DUE TO AN OPINION RENDERED BY DONALD J. SHERBONDY, SOLICITOR, FOR THE SOIL CONSERVATION SERVICE, IN THE AGRICULTURAL DEPARTMENT, WASHINGTON, D.C., IN WHICH HE STATES THAT A CHANGE CANNOT LEGALLY BE MADE AFTER THE DISTRICT IS LEGALLY SET UP.

THE RESULTS OF THE ELECTIONS HELD IN MENARD COUNTY, KENDALL COUNTY AND KERR COUNTY WERE RECEIVED, EACH ELECTION HAD CARRIED BY THE NECESSARY TWO THIRDS MAJORITY; A MOTION WAS MADE BY J.P. MARTIN, SECONDED BY C.M. CARAWAY THAT DETERMINATION THAT OPERATION OF A DISTRICT IS ADMINISTRATIVELY PRACTICABLE AND FEASIBLE IN EACH OF THESE DISTRICTS - MENARD COUNTY, KENDALL COUNTY AND KERR COUNTY. MOTION WAS ADOPTED.

THE RESULT OF THE ELECTION IN COLLIN COUNTY WAS REPORTED AS 240 VOTING FOR A SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT AND 205 VOTING AGAINST; THIS NOT BEING A TWO THIRDS MAJORITY A MOTION WAS MADE BY J.P. MARTIN AND SECONDED BY C.M. CARAWAY THAT THE OPERATION OF A DISTRICT IN COLLIN COUNTY IS NOT ADMINISTRATIVELY PRACTICABLE AND FEASIBLE,; MOTION ADOPTED.

ALL MEMBERS OF THE BOARD AND THE ADMINISTRATIVE DEPARTMENT ATTENDED THE MEETINGS OF THE STATE SOIL CONSERVATION SUPERVISORS, BEING HELD AT CISCO, TEXAS, DECEMBER 14, AND 15, 1943.
