

STATE SOIL CONSERVATION BOARD MEETING
STEPHEN F. AUSTIN HOTEL, AUSTIN, TEXAS
FEBRUARY 3, 1961

The State Soil Conservation Board met in Austin, Texas on February 3, 1961 at 9:00 a.m. for the primary purpose of participating in the Budget hearing with the Finance Committee of the Senate.

Members present were: Frank Gray, A. F. Leesch and E. W. Wehman.

Others present were: A. C. Spencer, Executive Director of the State Soil Conservation Board and H. B. Boswell, Executive Director of the Association of Texas Soil Conservation Districts.

In the absence of the Chairman and Vice Chairman, A. F. Leesch presided.

On motion by Frank Gray seconded by E. W. Wehman the name of the Dallam County Soil Conservation District #131 was officially changed to the Dallam Soil Conservation District contingent upon the Board of Supervisors supplying a resolution setting forth reasons for desiring the change and that it is the wish and action of the local board.

The matter of the date of the Annual State Meeting of Soil Conservation District Supervisors to be held in San Antonio, Texas in January 1962 was discussed. On motion by E. W. Wehman, seconded by Frank Gray, the dates were set as January 10, 11, and 12.

Following this discussion all present attended and participated in the Budget hearing.
