

OFFICIAL MINUTES
STATE SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION BOARD MEETING
FEBRUARY 6, 1968

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Leesch at 5:15 p.m.

Mr. John Kincaid, Assistant State Conservationist, acting for H. N. Smith, State Conservationist, reviewed the budget for the Soil Conservation Service for the fiscal year 1968, and how budget reductions will affect Texas. The reduction in funds affected the watershed construction fund by 50 percent.

The State Board and Directors of the Association scheduled a joint meeting for March 5, 1968, at 10:00 a.m. in the Stephen F. Austin Hotel, Austin, Texas.

A request to dissolve the Calhoun-Victoria Soil and Water Conservation District and to re-organize into two districts was reviewed. On motion of

Ernest Wehman, seconded by Frank Gray the Board approved the request to re-organize the District.

A request for new subdivisions in the Lower Trinity Soil and Water Conservation District was reviewed by the Board. On motion of Albert Roach, seconded by Ernest Wehman, the Board approved the subdivision change.

On motion of Albert Roach, seconded by Ernest Wehman, the Board approved the appointment of Patrick Boyt, as District Supervisor in the Lower Trinity Soil and Water Conservation District # 435.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:45 p.m.


