PROCESS FOR ACCEPTING AND RANKING WSEP PROJECTS

1. An application is submitted for consideration. A feasibility study is required. If one does not exist, the application is considered for a feasibility study grant (see Draft Feasibility Study Policy).
2. Applications are ranked according to process developed by Dr. Robert Mace, TWDB (see Power Point presentation demonstrating this process *Evaluation of Six Locations for Prioritization of Water Enhancement*).
3. GIS spatial analysis is performed to identify zones of high, medium, and low potential water yield (see Power Point presentation *Demonstration of Brush Removal Criteria for Water Supply Enhancement*). Zones of high potential water yield are considered eligible acres within a project area.
