Buck Creek Watershed

The Texas Well Owner Network (TWON) program is a free, one-day educational training for residents who want to become familiar with groundwater resources, septic system maintenance, well maintenance, water quality and water treatment. Private well owners are independently responsible for operating their wells and monitoring the quality of their water. The training will primarily focus on water quality issues in the Buck Creek Watershed as well as efforts by the Buck Creek Watershed Partnership, Texas Water Resources Institute, Texas A&M AgriLife and the Texas State Soil and Water Conservation Board to improve water resources in the area.

Bring your well water samples:

Well owners may bring water samples to the training to be screened for nitrate, total dissolved solids (TDS), arsenic and fecal coliform bacteria for \$10. Pick up approved sample bags with instructions at the Collingsworth, Wheeler, Donley, Hall or Childress County Extension offices. Bring your samples and payment of \$10 to the training on March 28.
