Minutes - State Soil Conservation Board Meeting, held at Temple, Friday May 29, 1942

Board called to order by the chairman at 9 a.m. with all members present.

Minutes from last meeting were read and adopted as read.

Administrator read statement from Chairmen and Secretaries of the District Conventions held on May 5th, in State Districts 1, 3, and 5, and these statements showed that the present members were re-elected from the above named districts. The Texas State Oath of Office was signed by Messrs. Kennedy, Caraway and Cardwell, the re-elected members of the Board.
