

Minutes- Meeting State Soil Conservation Board- Saturday, July 12, 1941.

The State Soil Conservation Board met in regular session at Temple Texas, Saturday July 12, 1941, with the entire membership present. Members are Walter W. Cardwell, H.K. Fawcett, J.P. Martin, C.M. Caraway and W.G. Kennedy.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Mr. Walter W. Cardwell at 10:00 A.M. and the following items of business were presented and officially handled;

The Administrator read a list of district supervisors who had been appointed or re-appointed to terms ending October 5, 1943 and upon motion of Mr. Kennedy, seconded by Mr. Martin, these appointments were approved. For list of these appointments see Exhibit A.

Upon motion of Mr. Fawcett, seconded by Mr. Martin, an election was ordered in three (3) subdivisions (Nos. 3, 4 and 5) of Upper Sabine Soil Conservation District No. 530 (Hunt County) to elect the three (3) supervisors needed for a complete organization... Date set for this election was Saturday, August 9th, 1941.

Upon motion of Mr. Kennedy, seconded by Mr. Caraway, an election was ordered in three (3) subdivisions (Nos. 2, 3 and 4) of Eldorado Divide Soil Conservation District No. 212 (Schleiker and Tom Greene Counties) to elect the three (3) supervisors needed to complete their legal organization... Date set for this election was Saturday, August 9th, 1941.

Petitions as submitted for proposed Soil Conservation Districts were determined to be practical and feasible in the following cases;

- Willacy-Hidalgo S.C. District No. 312
- Lynn County--No. 119
- Bastrop-Fayette County -District No. 310
- Burleson and Lee County -District No. 313

Motion made by Mr. Kennedy, seconded by Mr. Martin.

By agreement of all members it was decided not to set date for another hearing to be held in proposed District No. 513 (Lower Clear Fork of the Brazos) at Baird, Albany and Breckenridge Texas, until farmers of that section have had time to complete necessary work on their present growing farm crops and can give more attention to the district program.

The petition as presented by Rusk County for the formation of a district (No. 430) was refused consideration and declared not practical and feasible for the lack of interest by the resident farmers, the small acreage involved and the small number of individual farms that make up the proposed district. This motion made by Mr. Kennedy, seconded by Mr. Fawcett.

Approval of the Board was given to the Administrator's letter directed to the members of the Soil Conservation Supervisory Committee of Hale County and to the County Judge of Hale County--setting forth the cooperation extended between the State Soil Conservation Board and the Hale County Wind Erosion District and also advising that Committee of the administrative procedure required in the transaction of their official business with the State Board. Motion made by Mr. Kennedy, seconded by Mr. Martin.

Upon motion by Mr. Caraway, seconded by Mr. Fawcett, the resignation of Mr. Luke L. Ballard, as field Supervisor was accepted, effective as of July 9th, 1941, the date on which his services were terminated.

The Administrator gave a complete outline of the organization progress of each of the sixty-five(65) district now recognized as legal subdivisions of this state. For list reported see Exhibit B.

Minutes of the last meeting were read by Mr.Marshall,administrator and were adopted as read, This motion was made by Mr.Caraway,seconded by Mr.Fawcett.

The next meeting date of the Board was tentatively set for Saturday, August 30,1941.

Adjournment was at 3:30 P.M.
