

MINUTES OF TEXAS STATE SOIL CONSERVATION BOARD  
JULY 12, 1946

The Texas State Soil Conservation Board met in it's offices at Temple, Texas on July 12, 1946 at 9:00 a.m.

Members present were C. M. Caraway, Chairman, Walter W. Cardwell and J. P. Martin. Others present were V. C. Marshall, Executive Director, Howard H. Goss, Chief of Engineering and Planning and A. L. Liles, Assistant Executive Director.


The minutes of the meeting of June 1 were read and approved. On motion made by Mr. Cardwell, 2nd by Mr. Martin, the determination of Need for creation of soil conservation districts in Hale County, Edwards Plateau and Jim Hogg Counties were approved.

The Determination that operation of districts in Lamb County, Hockley County, Gaines County, Coke County, Nueces-Frio-Sabinal, and Collin County were administratively Practicable and Feasible was approved on motion by Mr. Cardwell and 2nd by Mr. Caraway.

The appointment of two supervisors in the Gaines County S.C.D., Mr. S. W. Bryan and J. F. McCulloch was approved.

A letter from Mr. Herman F. Kruger requesting that the annual meeting of the State District Supervisors Association be held in Austin was read and action was deferred.

No further business appearing for attention the Board adjourned at 12 noon.
