THE TEXAS STATE SOIL CONSERVATION BOARD MET IN IT OFFICES AT
TEMPLE, TEXAS, OCTOBER 29, 1946, AT 8:30 A.M.

MEMBERS PRESENT WERE C.M. CARAWAY, CHAIRMAN, J.P. MARTIN,
WALTER W. CARDWELL AND S.J. PAYNE. OTHERS PRESENT WERE V.C. MARSHALL,
EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, HOWARD H. GOSS, CHIEF OF ENGINEERING AND PLANNING,
AND AL. LILES, EXECUTIVE ASSISTANT.

THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD AUGUST 30, 1946, WERE
READ AND APPROVED. A MOTION WAS DULY MADE AND PASSED THAT THE
DETERMINATION OF NEED FOR THE INCLUSION OF ADDITIONAL TERRITORY
TO THE UPPER PECOS SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT No. 213, AND TO THE
EL PASO-HUDSPETH SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT No. 205, WERE APPROVED.

UPON A MOTION DULY MADE AND PASSED IT WAS DETERMINED THAT THE OPERATION
OF SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICTS IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS IS ADMINISTRATIVELY
PRACTICABLE AND FEASIBLE; SALT FORK, No. 133; MASON COUNTY No. 223;
COPANO BAY No. 329; MONTE MUCHO No. 331 AND THE INCLUSION OF ADDITIONAL
TERRITORY IN THE EL PASO-HUDSPETH DISTRICT No. 205.

MR. MARSHALL EXPLAINED TO THE BOARD THE NECESSITY FOR THE PURCHASE OF
A NEW MIMEOGRAPH MACHINE WHICH WOULD REQUIRE THE REQUEST FOR A DEFICIENCY
APPROPRIATION. A MOTION WAS MADE BY J.P. MARTIN AND SECONDED BY W.R.
WALTER W. CARDWELL THAT THE BOARD REQUEST SAID DEFICIENCY APPROPRIATION;
MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
