THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF OCTOBER 29, 1946, WERE READ AND APPROVED. IT WAS DETERMINED THAT THE OPERATION OF A SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT IN STARR COUNTY WAS ADMINISTRATIVELY PRACTICABLE AND FEASIBLE.
