MINUTES OF DISTRICT MEETING - CROCKETT

On May 6, 1952, the District meeting, as provided for in HB 444, Acts of the 47th Legislature, regular session, was held in the District Court Room, Crockett, Texas, at 1 p.m.

Mr J P Martion, whose term had expired as a Member of the State Board, opened the meeting and briefly stated its purpose, after which he requested Mr A L Liles, Executive Assistant from the State Office to serve as temporary Chairman,. Mr Liles advised the meeting that he would now call the roll of the accredited, properly elected Delegates as shown by the records in the State Office; the roll was called and it was developed that there were thirty two delegates present. That being a majority of all the delegates elected the next order of business was the selection of a Chairman. Mr Dan Sparks of Bowie County was elected. Mr Liles then turned the meeting over to Mr Sparks who selected Mr Jeff O Chumley, Secretary.

The Chairman then advised that nominations for a State Board Member for District No.4 would be in order. Mr Belton Latimer nominated Mr J P Martin. Mr Roland S Dodson nominated Mr J W Trousdale. Mr Martin was then asked if he would accept another term and he advised that he would accept Mr J W Trousdale requested Mr Roland S Dodson to withdraw his name from consideration, which he did and Mr J P Martin was then elected by acclamation,

A Water Conservation Resolution was then presented by Mr Carl Wipprecht which was adopted by a unanimous vote. Copy of resolution hereto attached.

A motion was then made by Mr W B McGinney, Smith County, seconded by Mr Worth Thompson, of Henderson County, that the State Board consider holding the Annual Meeting of the District Supervisors in Tyler, Texas, motion carried.

A Resolution indorsing the fine work done by State Board Member J P Martin was presented by Mr Carl Wipprecht and seonded by Mr J W Trousdale - Resolution unanimously adopted.

The Meeting was adjourned at 2 o'clock p.m.

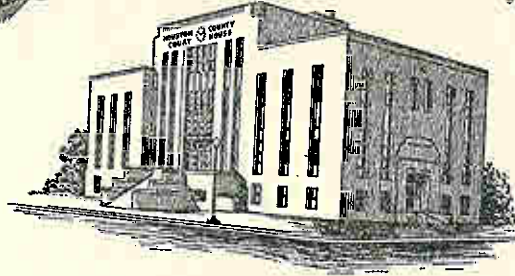


