

TSSWCB Information Resources Security Acknowledgment

Automated information and information resources owned or managed by the Texas State Soil and Water Conservation Board (TSSWCB) are strategic and vital resources belonging to the people of Texas. These resources are entrusted to the TSSWCB to accomplish its mission.

Regardless of the funding source, the network and information resources are owned by the TSSWCB and are governed by agency rules, which arise from state regulations.

The TSSWCB has delegated the responsibility for overseeing the information security program to the information resource manager (IRM). All information resources attached to the TSSWCB network fall under the authority and responsibility of the IRM and must meet the minimum security requirements of the TSSWCB and appropriate state regulations and policies.

The security requirements and practices of the TSSWCB are outlined in the policies available online from the TSSWCB IT Policies page of the TSSWCB Intranet at the following URL: <https://www.tsswcb.texas.gov/tsswcb-it-policies>.

Individuals using the TSSWCB network and information resources owned or managed by the agency are expected to know and comply with published agency policies and procedures. Failure on the part of any individual to comply may result in disciplinary action including termination for employees and temporaries; a termination of employment relations in the case of contractors or consultants; or dismissal for interns and volunteers. Additionally, individuals are subject to loss of TSSWCB information resources access privileges, and civil, and criminal prosecution.

It is the responsibility of all personnel to report any suspected or confirmed violations to appropriate management.
